Where pupils fall below 90% they are then ranked as Persistent Absentees. These pupils miss out on important learning and we are here to help if you or your child needs support in improving attendance. The BWCET new policy for attendance is now finalised and will be distributed via our new website asap. Please request a hard copy from the office if you would like one. We will continue to communicate with individual families as required where there is a concern around attendance. Please note that our half term in February is week beginning 12<sup>th</sup> February and this is the week before the county schools. We have been assured that this is a one off and holidays will be aligned in future years.

<u>Parent Support group (Autism support)</u> Please remember that we have a joint St Pius and Our Lady and St Joseph's support group. Our regular sessions are communicated via our Facebook page. Please ask in the office if you want to learn more about this group or would like to speak to parents who attend already to see if it is something you would like to attend. Parents / carers and grandparents are welcome to come along.

<u>Holy Communion Session –</u> The next teaching session will be Sunday 17th March,2024. Doors open at 9.00a.m. so children can have a drink and start the session asap.

<u>Coats</u> – Please make sure your child comes to school with a coat. It is very cold and wet and a coat needs to be worn. Please ensure that boots / wellies / shoes have names in. Thank you!
