However, we completely appreciate that they are one week out of 7 years in our school and we could make a list a mile long of all the amazing achievements, gifts and talents we have observed from them in that time. We know that they will all do their very best and we will be very proud of them for doing so. As expected, a magnificent breakfast will be available for Year 6 pupils from Monday to Thursday from 8.15 onwards. Our usual breakfast club will take place in Class 1 from 8a.m. as normal.

<u>Head Lice –</u> Could you make sure that you check your child's hair on regular basis and treat if necessary. Please make sure long hair is tied back so we can avoid any cases spreading.

<u>Attendance</u> – As you will be aware our new trust policy for attendance can be viewed on our website (Link) As outlined in the policy holiday absence cannot be authorised and unauthorised absence reaching 7 days or 14 sessions within a 12-week period will be subject to a fixed penalty notice. Children that are still below 90%

attendance will have received a letter at the end of term and we will review these in 4 weeks. We will then arrange meetings with parents to discuss how we can improve attendance where required.

Parent Support group (Autism support) Please remember that we have a joint St Pius and Our Lady and St Joseph's support group. Our regular sessions are communicated via our Facebook page.
