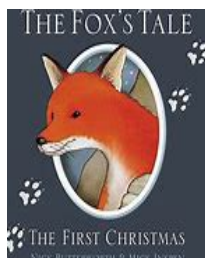
P.E.

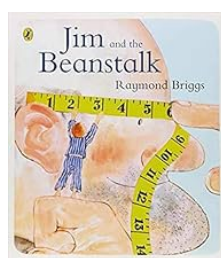
Parking

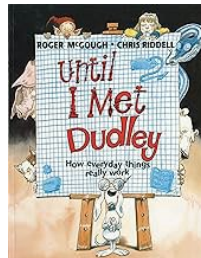

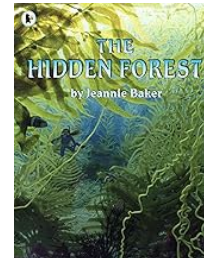
